The Curriculum

The Kingdom Kids curriculum includes both preschool and school-age lessons.

Seeds of Faith

Seeds of Faith takes the children from preschool through second grade. It introduces them to six exciting and dynamic learning centers: Bible Story; Life Application; Craft; Game; Scripture Memory and Bible Skills. This curriculum plan will take the children through both the Old and New Testaments with such units as: The Adventures of Moses; Creation; Young Heroes for God; and Obedience. Together with a Parent Letter for each unit, these lessons promise to help children relate biblical concepts to their everyday experiences.



Generation: Next

Where *Seeds of Faith* ends, *Generation: Next* picks up. This curriculum begins with the third grade and continues through the preteen years, training each student to make godly choices. Using the Bible, students will explore God's awesome creation, travel through the Red Sea, dig up evidences, cross over to the Promised Land and even peer into an empty tomb. These lessons allow the students to apply important Bible principles to their everyday lives.

Teachers

All teachers must be members in good standing of the WCCC for at least six months prior to volunteering, and undergo a screening which includes a state background check. Our teachers volunteer for a four month rotation during which they are in class on Sundays, and two Wednesdays per month. This helps establish a close bond with the children and their parents. It is also beneficial in maintaining consistent routines and expectations within the class. Our teachers have great hearts for God and a sincere desire to help the children know Him better.

Getting Acquainted

- ☞ Some children have no anxiety about mingling with a new group of friends, while others are more hesitant. Any insights you could briefly pass along to the teachers about your child would be useful in helping them adjust to the new environment. Also if your child has allergies, or any other needs that may impact them during class, please pass that information along as well.
- ☞ All classes have a snack time during the period. The children each bring their own snack.
- ☞ Children need to be signed in, and out of, class by a parent or guardia.
